\$25 MILLION AVAILABLE FOR ZERO-EMISSION TRANSIT BUSES & CHARGERS



The MSRC (Mobile Source Air Pollution Reduction Review Committee) has up to \$25 million available for its new Zero-Emission Transit Bus Incentive Program. The Program Announcement is seeking submissions from transit agencies to buy-down the cost of new zero-emission transit buses and chargers operating within the South Coast Air Quality Management District to accelerate the transition to a zero-emission fleet.

- Eligible applicants include: Large and small public transit agencies subject to the Innovative Clean Transit Regulation.
- Qualifying transit buses include: Class 4-8 heavy-duty zero-emission battery-electric and hydrogen fuel cell buses.
- Qualifying chargers: Charging units (i.e., dispensers) to charge battery-electric transit buses.
